Dear Ms. Hantak:

We have received the above revised labeling and Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. The results of our review of these documents follow.

A. Revised Labeling. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship product:

1. Since the product is less than 16 ounces, remove all references to closet because there is not enough product to treat an entire closet.
2. In application directions, replace "Take off cellophane wrap...replace cake in box" to "Unwrap the cake, and while holding it by its cellophane wrapper, transfer it back to the box."
3. Replace the statement "To aid in control of mildew: Use 1 cake to every 14,400 cubic inches* of tightly enclosed space" with "Aids in mildew control" because the rate of application must be no more than one pound of product per 50 cubic feet of tightly-enclosed space.
4. In storage and disposal, change "do not empty container" to "do not reuse empty container."
5. Change the statement "Prevents moth infestation regardless of fabric type" to "For use only on cloth containing wool or wool blends."
6. In the Notice section, "performed" is misspelled.
7. Revise the Ingredient Statement as follows:



If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

B. Revised CSF The Agency has determined that the CSF dated May 20, 1998, is acceptable. A copy of this CSF has been retained in our files for this product. All previous versions are obsolete.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

KILLS CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES

Delete
Use Restrictions: Kills clothes moths (larvae and adults) and carpet beetles in clean, air-tight containers (e.g., chests and trunks) and garment bags. Do not use in containers, dry cleaning and garbage bags, or closets that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. Do not use this product with any other moth control chemical. As Paradichlorobenzene damages some plastics, use only in polyethylene or polypropylene containers. *OK?*

Pre-Application Directions: Before storing, dry clean, wash or brush articles to be protected.

Prevents moth infestation regardless of fabric type.

OK to touch?
Application Directions: Open flap, remove cake from box. Take off cellophane wrap...replace cake in box. Punch out all vent holes. Attach box at top of garment bag (or hanger) or to a wire, because vapors work downward. It is advisable to keep block from touching fabrics since it contains fragrant perfume oils that may stain, just as your personal perfume may. Apply product in clean, air-tight containers listed above at the rate of 1 cake for 12.5 cubic feet of confined space. For a garment bag, multiply the width, depth and length and divide by 5400" to determine the number of ounces of product needed. For example, garment bag 60" long, 30" wide and 12" deep (i.e. 21,600" cubic inches) would need 4 ounces of product. To aid in control of mildew - *Use 1 cake to every 17,400 cubic inches of tightly enclosed space.*

Post-Application Directions: Keep product in air-tight space for a minimum of seven (7) days.

Odor dissipates when treated articles are aired.

Retreatment: Since moths are active all year, replenish air-tight containers, bags, and closets 2 times a year or when product has dissipated.

WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes eye, skin, and respiratory tract irritation. Wear safety glasses. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing wash before reuse.

NOTICE: This product contains a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer.

This conclusion was based on scientific studies performed on laboratory animals.

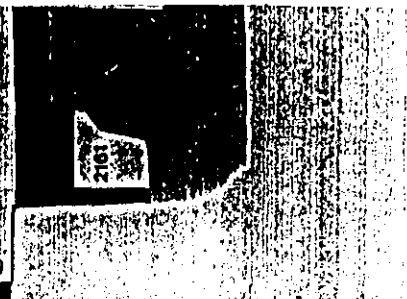
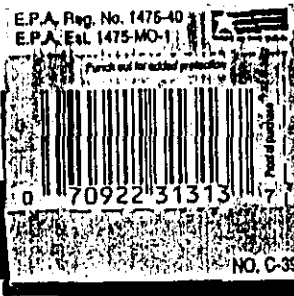
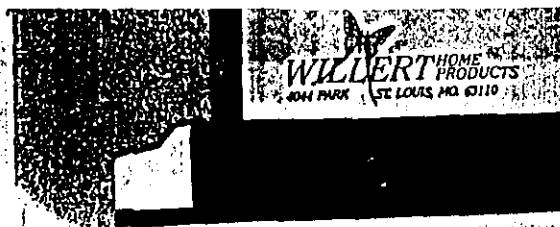
IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
