Purpose The purpose of your submission is to revise your CSF and label, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) .

CSF Your CSF dated March 25, 2003, is acceptable. We have placed a copy in our files. All other versions are obsolete.

Label The label submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling, including graphics, to us before you release product for shipment. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

Label-continued

1. Modify your "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS [centered, bolded]

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals [left justified, bolded]

WARNING [left justified, bolded]

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes eye, skin, and respiratory tract irritation. Wear safety glasses. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. 3. Replace "Add the following text at the end of your use directions:

Retreatment: Since moths are active all year, replenish air-tight containers and bags 2 times a year.

4. Revise your "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" text as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse empty container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Existing stocks

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

Consequence for non-compliance If these conditions are not complied with, the registrations will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Directions for Use:

Use Restrictions: This product can treat up to 12.5 cubic feet for moth protection and 6.25 cubic feet for mildew protection. Kills Clothes moths and Carpet beetles and their eggs and larvae in clean, airtight containers, such as chests, trunks, and garment bags. Do not use dry cleaning bags, garbage bags or other containers that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. This product can damage some plastics, use only in polyethylene or polypropylene containers. Paradichlorobenzene should not be mixed or placed in contact with other moth preventive chemicals. Prevents moth infestation regardless of fabric type.

Pre-Application Directions: Before storing, dry clean, wash or brush articles to be protected.

Application Directions: Open package. Remove cake and punch out all vent holes on package. Unwrap the cake, and while holding cake by the cellophane wrapper, transfer back into the package. Place the filled package at the top of the storage container. The vapors work downward. Keep product in airtight space for a minimum of 7 days. When cake has dissipated replace with new unit. Odor quickly vanishes when articles are aired.
