Purpose

The purpose of your submission is to revise your CSF and label, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). You requested that your April 10 submission supercede your March 3, 2003, submission.

CSF

Your CSFs dated April 10, 2003, including a Basic Formulation and an Alternative Formulation, are unacceptable. We need to know the complete chemical identity of the last ingredient in each of the formulations. If the composition of these ingredients are **not** known to you, your supplier may forward the information, including the registration number of this product, directly to us.

Label

The label submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the following change submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling, including graphics, to us before you release product for shipment. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Use of the words, "Cedar-Ize" and "Cedar", in your product name are misleading because they imply that the active ingredient is "cedar" while you make no such claim for this product. Take one of the following actions:
 - a. Delete the misleading words.
 - b. Add the following words immediately below the product name: "Contains paradiclorobenzene as the active ingredient and a cedar scent as an inert ingredient." in the same type and size as the product name.

- 2. If you use the words "Cedar-Ize" or "Cedar" as part of your product name, your formula must contain a cedar scent and not any other scent.
- 3. You may not use the word "pine" in a product name because you do not have a pine scented formula.
- 4. Modify your "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" as follows:
