Enclosed please find our Notification of label change per PR Notice 98-10 to add the optional marketing phrases New Improved Lavender Scent!, New Improved Cedar Scent!, and New Linen Scent! for a period of six months beginning when our products with these claims are first sold or distributed. The Agency recently approved new fragrances for use in this formula and we plan to introduce them to the marketplace shortly. We are also adding the phrase Linen Scented for use when our six months have expired. We are also taking this opportunity to add "Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container." to the Disposal section per PR Notice 2007-4, to change "Inert ingredients" to "Other ingredients" per PR Notice 97-6, and to correct net weight statements throughout the label.
