The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Naphthalene Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.



If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must

submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

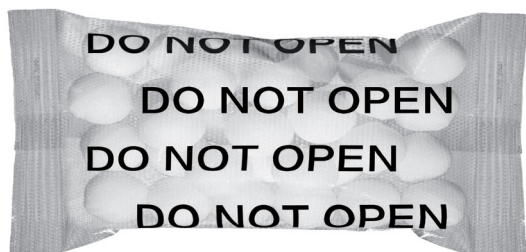
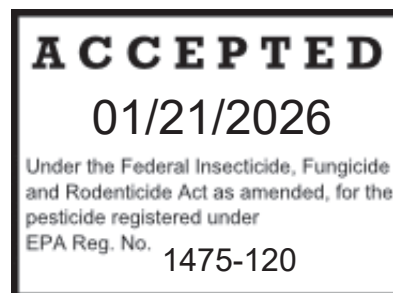

Kills clothes moths and their eggs and larvae in clean, airtight containers, which could include chests, trunks, garment bags and storage closets. Do not use dry cleaning bags, garbage bags or other containers that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. If the product's smell persists after placing it inside a container and sealing it, that container is not airtight and is not suitable for applying this product. Do not mix naphthalene or use it together with other moth preventive chemicals. For use only on cloth containing wool or wool blends. To insure protection of clothing, follow the application directions carefully. Do not apply more product than specified for the area being treated. [Statement for use with wrapped sachet products required after 9/30/13:] **IMPORTANT: It is illegal to sell the sachets individually. Do not open sachets.]**

Application Directions: The mothballs in this container can treat up to 31.3 cubic feet (for 10 oz. box) [15.6 cubic feet for 5 oz. box; 18.7 cubic feet for 6 oz. box; 37.5 cubic feet for 12 oz. box; 43.7 cubic feet for 14 oz. box; 50 cubic feet for 16 oz. box; 75 cubic feet for 24 oz. box]. One ounce or 10 mothballs can treat 3 cubic feet.

Apply product in clean, airtight containers, bags and closets at the following rates:

4	Average Garment Bag (12 cu. ft.)
5	Large Trunk (15 cu. ft.)
16	Small Closet (50 cu. ft.) <i>(only for 16 and 24 oz. containers)</i>

For [larger] closets and [larger] containers, calculate the volume to be treated by multiplying the height, width, and depth of the space. The proper treatment of larger volumes may require the use of additional containers of ENOZ® Cedar Pine Moth Balls. To insure protection of your clothes use the recommended amount of ENOZ® Cedar Pine Moth Balls.

Post-Application Directions: Keep product in airtight space for a minimum of seven (7) days. Odor dissipates when treated articles are aired.

Re-treatment: Moths are active all year. In order to maintain protection of your garments, replenish mothballs that have dissipated.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store in the original container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.
