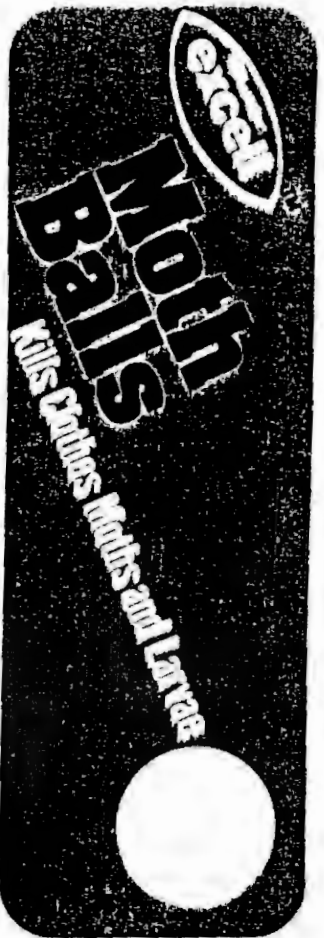
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Brush all articles thoroughly to be stored and protected. Place them in an airtight storage container. Cover generously with Excell Moth Balls. Spread liberally with one pound for each 50 cubic feet of confined storage space. An average storage closet (5' x 2' x 9') requires a minimum of 2 pounds. Replenish periodically with Excell Moth Balls to maintain protection. When unpacked, articles should be thoroughly brushed and hung in the air and sunlight to eliminate odor. Naphthalene should not be mixed with other moth preventive chemicals or placed on painted, polished or plastic surfaces.
