Your letter amended application of May 7, 2003

- Purpose** The purpose of your submission is to revise your labeling and CSF, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).
- CSF** Your two CSFs dated May 7, 2003, a new Basic Formulation and a new Alternative Formulation, are acceptable. We have placed copies in our files for this product. All other versions are obsolete.
- Label** The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling, with the following changes, to us before you ship your product.
1. Your headings and subheadings do not follow a consistent format, thus making it difficult to follow your label's structure. One way to make the format clearer is to center the main headings (**DIRECTIONS FOR USE** and **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**) and left justify the subheadings (**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals** and **Physical or Chemical Hazard**). If you have an alternative method of accomplishing the same goal, you are free to use it.
 2. You need to make a greater distinction between selected subheadings and text. We would suggest bolding words like **Use Restrictions**, **Pre-Application Directions**, **Application Directions**, **Retreatment**, **Storage**, **Disposal**, **If empty**, and **If partly filled** to make these key words stand out from the text. Again, if you have an alternative method of accomplishing the same goal, you are free to use it.

A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

- Existing stocks** Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.
- Consequence for non-compliance** If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of this condition.

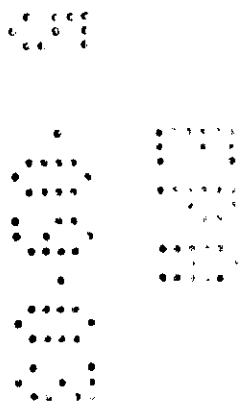

Enoz Moth-Tek (Reefer-Galler Moth Tek) combines one of the most effective mothproofing ingredients available with a fresh lavender (cedar) scent to create a hard-working mothball that actually smells good! These fresh-smelling mothballs are enclosed in breathable paper packets, which allow the active ingredients to work while protecting you and your clothes from messy flakes and residue.

Directions for Use:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Restrictions: This product can treat up to 18.75 cubic feet. Kills Clothes moths and Carpet beetles and their eggs and larvae in clean, airtight containers, such as chests, trunks, and garment bags. Do not use dry cleaning bags, garbage bags or other containers that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. This product can damage some plastics, use only in polyethylene or polypropylene containers.

Paradichlorobenzene should not be mixed or placed in contact with other moth preventive chemicals or placed on painted, polished or plastic surfaces.

Pre-Application Directions: Clean all fabrics before storage. Prevents moth infestation regardless of fabric type.

Application Directions: Calculate the volume to be treated in cubic feet by multiplying the height by the width, and depth of the space. Seven packets can treat about 3 cubic feet of storage space. Examples of the amount of product required for proper treatment are listed below:

- 7 packets Small storage box (3 cu. ft.)
- 28 packets Average Garment Bag (12 cu. ft.)
- 35 packets Large Trunk (15 cu. ft.)

The proper treatment of larger volumes may require the use of additional containers of packets. To insure protection of your cloths, use the recommended amount of packets. Do not remove the mothballs from the packets. Scatter packets throughout the storage area. Storage containers should be tightly closed at all times to maximize protection. Keep product in airtight space for a minimum of 7 days. Replace when mothballs have dissipated. Odor quickly vanishes when articles are aired.
