	 Your headings and subheadings do not follow a consistent format, thus making it difficult to follow your label's structure. One way to make the format clearer is to center the main headings (DIRECTIONS FOR USE and PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS) and left justify the subheadings (Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals and Physical or Chemical Hazard). If you have an alternative method of accomplishing the same goal, you are free to use it. 		
	2. You need to make a greater distinction between selected subheadings and text. We would suggest bolding words like Use Restrictions, Pre-Application Directions, Application Directions, Retreatment, Storage, Disposal, If empty, and If partly filled to make these key words stand out from the text. Again, if you have an alternative method of accomplishing the same goal, you are free to use it.
