Do not remove the mothballs from the packets. Scatter packets throughout the storage area. Storage containers should be tightly closed at all times to maximize protection. Keep storage containers tightly closed at all times. Replace when mothballs have dissipated. Odor quickly vanishes when articles are aired.
