DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

• STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

• **STORAGE:** Store only in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Do not store at elevated temperatures. Material melts at 176° F (80° C). In case of spill or leak, sweep up or shovel into clean metal containers. Dispose of pesticide and container as indicated below.

• PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
