Enclosed please find our Notification of label change per PR Notice 98-10 to add *optional* condensed formats for Directions for Use and First Aid in order to fit all required text onto a small package for retail sale. The Directions for Use include the same words as the original version, but have been condensed from six steps into three, and one optional graphic has been eliminated. The First Aid section is presented in a paragraph format, instead of boxed, but still contains bolded headings so consumers can quickly find the information they need. These optional formats have been included for both the outer carton and the inner coil wrapper. The following documents are included:

- 1. One application on EPA Form 8750-1
- 2. Two copies of revised labeling, plus another copy with the additions highlighted.
- 3. One copy of our most recent stamped accepted label dated October 22, 2008, and Final Printed Labeling submitted November 5, 2008, for your reference.

This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 98-10 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146 and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146 and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
