On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.



This product may be used to formulate products for any additional uses not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such uses.

It is the responsibility of the manufacturer of such products to develop specific directions for use that are appropriate and in compliance with applicable government regulations. If assistance is required, contact Willert Home Products or the Office of Pesticide Programs at U.S. EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
