1. Revise the claim:

“Kills Cockroaches, Ants, Silver fish, Palmetto Bugs, Waterbugs” to read as follows:
“Kills Silverfish, Cockroaches (Palmetto Bugs, Waterbugs), Ants, (Except Pharaoh, Ants, Fire Ants, Carpenter Ants, Harvester Ants).”

2. Revise the “For homeowner use only” statement under Directions for use to read “For use in residential areas only.” See 40 CFR 152.3.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For homeowner use only:

To control cockroaches, ants, silverfish, palmetto bugs, and waterbugs: Apply liberally, scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs; into openings around drains, water pipes and electrical conduits; and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of drawers, then scatter liberally in drawer wells. Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Children and pets should not be in the treatment area until application is complete. Do not treat pets with this product. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.
