PARA-ZENE

When exposed to the air, it evaporates, releasing a vapor which kills clothes moths and larvae and carpet beetles, when used as directed.

DIRECTIONS

Thoroughly brush articles to be stored. Place the garments, furs, woollens, etc., in an air-tight storage container. Use 1 lb. of PARA-ZENE for every 50 cubic feet of tightly confined space. If the storage container is occasionally opened, more PARA-ZENE should be added and the storage container re-sealed for at least seven days.

AS A DEODORANT

Place PARA-ZENE in an open container. The ingredients evaporate freely producing a clean and pleasant odor.

AS A MILDEW PREVENTIVE

Use in air-tight container—closet doors should be kept closed and sealed. Use at least 1 ounce for every 3 cubic feet of tightly confined space.

USE WITH VACUUM CLEANERS

Fill Vacuum Cleaner container with PARA-ZENE, aim the machine so as to force PARA-ZENE vapor and small pieces into all corners, cracks, crevices, and seams as well as onto flat surfaces.

With rugs, all edges and the bottom should be treated with PARA-ZENE. With upholstered furniture, PARA-ZENE should be sprinkled under the cushions.
