DIRECTIONS

To protect animals against attacks of house flies, stable flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats, apply just enough Fly Repellent to wet the ends of the hair but not enough to soak the skin. One or two ounces is usually enough for an adult animal. This may be applied as a spray in a hand sprayer, or wipe on with a cloth or sponge.

Apply once daily, preferably in the morning.

Repeat daily or as necessary to give continued protection.
