DIRECTIONS

FLEAS - Wet the animal thoroughly with water, then while animal is still wet, apply FLEACIDE PET SHAMPOO. Use about 3 tablespoonfuls for medium or average sized dog. Carefully work the liquid into the hair until a pronounced lather is formed over the entire body. It is usually desirable to rinse the dog after the shampoo treatment. If the animal is rinsed, repeat the treatment as needed. If the lather is allowed to dry on the hair it will aid in protecting the animal against reinfestation for about one week so that less frequent applications of the shampoo will be needed.

LICE - Apply in same manner as directed for fleas to kill motile or active stages of lice. Repeat in one week to kill young lice that may have hatched since the treatment. Repeat as needed. EAR MITES - Syringe the ears with warm water and apply a few drops of the undiluted FLEA-CIDE PET SHAMPOO in the ears so that it can penetrate the remaining wax and surrounding tissues. Repeat as needed.
