**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For best results D-Leaf M should be applied to mature plants. The usual signs of maturity include a slight yellowing of the foliage and a reddish tinge on the leaves and stems. If there is any question as to the maturity of the plants, consult your state agricultural experiment station.

Plants should not be stressed for water when D-Leaf M is applied since tough wilted leaves tend to hinder the uptake of the chemical and prevent growth of the abscission layer.

D-Leaf M should be applied at the rate of 2 gallons per acre. If an airplane applicator is used the 2 gallons should be diluted with 8 gallons of water.

If a ground applicator is used the 2 gallons should be diluted with from 15 to 30 gallons of water. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
