

This product is for the control of bollworm, cotton fleahopper, cotton leafworm, leaf rollers, pink bollworm and cotton leaf perforator on cotton. Apply at the rate of 15 pounds per acre in a manner to give thorough coverage of the affected portions of the crop-plants. For control of salt-marsh caterpillar, apply at the rate of 20 pounds per acre. Begin applications when a damageable or potentially damageable infestation of the insects appear and continue treatments at weekly intervals as additional control is needed. For further specific information consult your State Agricultural Extension Service.

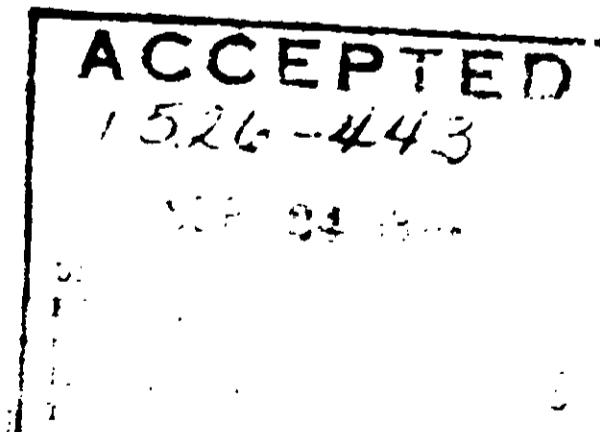

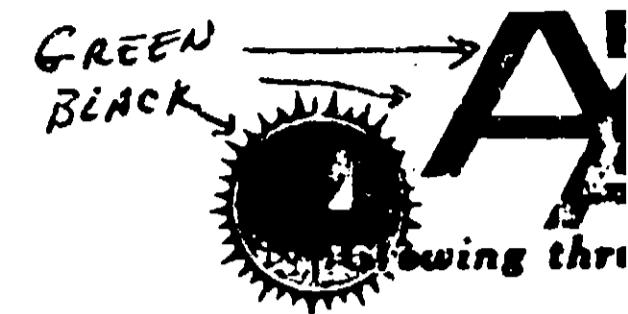

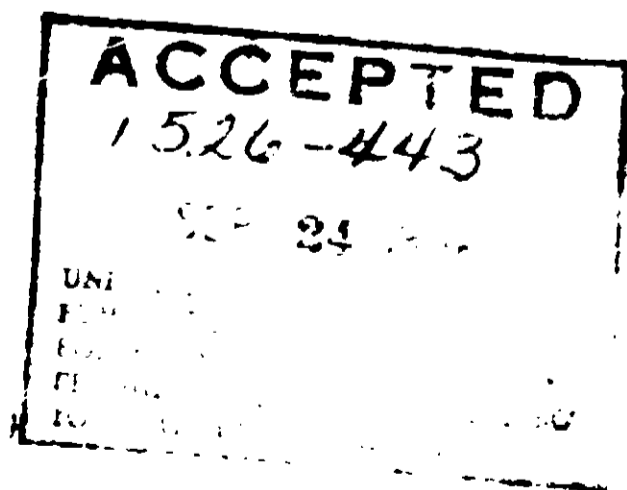
