SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and food-stuffs. Cover or remove fish bowls. Do not use on edible crops.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

KILLS: Mosquitoes, gnats, houseflies, biting flies, roaches, aphids (plant lice), leafhoppers, spittlebugs, plant bugs, spiders, Japanese beetles, wasps, ants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Aqueous Pressurized Spray Insecticide - Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

INDOORS - FOR MOSQUITOES, HOUSEFLIES AND GNATS: Close off doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

INDOORS - FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, crickets, grain mites, earwigs, spiders and centipedes: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, under baseboard, openings around pipes and sills, under mattresses, under carpets, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

INDOORS - FOR USE ON HOME PLANTS: Spray infested plants with all stems, branches, leaves, stems for control of aphids, spider mites and other insects. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS: Reduce annoyance from gnats (biting), houseflies, biting flies and flying insects by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 16 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated area. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO CONTROL ORNAMENTAL PLANT PESTS: Spray plants against gnats, aphids, whiteflies, leafhoppers, plant bugs, earwigs, crickets, grasshoppers, and other insects. Direct spray on insects by holding nozzle 16 to 24 inches from the treated plants. Spray in short burst of one second. Rate of one linear foot of growth per second. Spray until slightly moist. Avoid heavy watering.

PLANTS TO AVOID: Flowering Quince, Juniper, Cypress, Camellia, Azalea, Pyracantha and Cononopsis, as they may suffer leaf browning.

PLANTS TO AVOID: Deciduous trees and shrubs as they may suffer leaf browning. Avoid spraying on holly, privet, yew, cedar, pine, tree spurge, ivy, viburnum, oak, maple, lily, geranium, and rose for control of aphids. Use other parts listed above. Also spray infested flowering plants as petunia, iris, zinnia, geranium, ageratum, chrysanthemum, nasturtium, daisy, geranium, marigold, gladiolus, gladiolus, lily, rose, spray also, broadleaf weevil for the listed pest.

OUTDOORS - TO CONTROL NUISANCE PESTS ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS: Wasps: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS: Spray directly on spiders in crevices and other hiding places on porches, patio floors and doorway entrances. Repeat application as necessary.
