## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For Use on Cattle, Sheep, and Horses

#### To Operate:

Hold container outlet about 3 inches from wound or infested area. Be sure opening is directed toward area to be treated. Press valve down to release spray. Wet thoroughly by spraying directly into and about 1" around wound.

Screw-worm and Blowfly Infestations:
Use particular care to spray into deep pockets caused by screw-worms. Re-treat at 5 to 7 day intervals as necessary.

### To prevent Screw-worm and Blowfly Infestations:

Apply directly to all open or fresh wounds resulting from dehorning, castrations, shear cuts, etc. Also treat navels of newborn animals. Freely bleeding wounds may require several applications. Re-treat at 5 to 7 day intervals as needed.

## Fleece Worm Infestations:

Spray infested areas liberally, working toward the center of infestation. Shearing or removing wool from the infested area is not necessary. Re-treat at 5 to 7 day intervals as needed.
