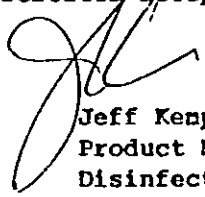

To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed equipment add 1 fluid oz. of BIOPAL LP-II to 6.5 Gallons of water. [25 ppm titratable iodine]. Apply with a suitable applicator such as a brush or sponge generously to thoroughly wet the surface. Allow a minimum contact time of one minute. For small articles or utensils use a bath containing 1 fluid oz. of BIOPAL LP-II in 6.5 gallons of water [25 ppm titratable iodine]. Allow items to soak a minimum of one minute. Allow to drain thoroughly but do not rinse. When used in this manner BIOPAL LP-II does not require a potable water rinse in accordance with the Food and Drug Administration Code of Federal Regulations.

FOR ONE-STEP CLEANING/DISINFECTING OF ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES IN FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, MILK HANDLING AND PROCESSING EQUIPMENT:

To clean and disinfect walls, floors, and tables, or food processing, milk-handling and processing equipment add 5 fluid oz. of Biopal LP-II to 6.5 gallons of water (125 ppm titratable iodine). Apply with suitable applicator such as sponge, or mop so as to wet the surfaces thoroughly for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes. For extra dirty surfaces, clean gross filth first, then proceed as above. Rinse with potable water.
