Dear Ms. Khattar:

The application for amended registration of the subject product in support of continuing registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions.


- As part of the current reregistration eligibility decision process, the precautionary statements need to be revised as follows: **Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or in clothing. Wear goggles, face shield, or safety glasses. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust, vapor, or spray mist. Wear a respirator with an organic-vapor removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-23C), or a canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G), or a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic vapor (OV) cartridge or canister with any N, R, P, or HE prefilter. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.**
- The First Aid need to be revised as following order: If in Eyes, If Inhaled, If on Skin or Clothing, and If Swallowed. In the instructions after If Swallowed change "**Have a person**" to **Have person**.
- Under Environmental Hazards change the word "**affluent**" to **effluent** and the word "**wit**" to **with**.

In summary, your request to add use directions and remove the HI and I uses (liquid detergents, soft soaps, roomdeodorizers and air fresheners, water based gels for household and industrial products is acceptable.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use as a preservative in latex paints, latex emulsions, pigment dispersions, inks, adhesives, construction materials, metalworking fluids, textile fiber-finish solutions, pulp and paper (treated paper and paper board intended for producing manufacturing, packaging, processing, treating or preparing food products must be limited to contact with dry food), general use in petroleum production recovery, and wax emulsions.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE** - Store indoors in a cool, dry place. Protect from heat and flame. Keep from freezing. Wear organic vapor respirator, face shield and rubber gloves when opening container and transferring contents. Reseal open container. If pesticide is spilled, extinguish sources of ignition, ventilate area and cover spill with inert absorbent material. Sweep up and dispose of as below.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** - Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous.
