PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DANGER

CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid breathing vapor. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A water soluble, liquid organic biocide (also called an antimicrobial or in-can preservative), recommended for use as an industrial preservative for the protection of water-based systems such as caulks, sealants, grouts, spackling, ready-mixed wallboard compounds, resin emulsions, latex paints, adhesives, inks, dispersed colors and ready-mixed joint cements among others against microbial deterioration. Typical use levels range from 0.05 to 0.5% by weight in the final formulation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS - Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS - Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Proper protective equipment, as indicated above, should be worn when opening, transferring and using product. Close bung drums tightly when not in use. Spill-leak procedures and additional handling information are contained in the Material Safety Data Sheet.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL - Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
