FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Possible mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or doctor, or going for treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A low viscosity formulation used in the preservation of ready-mixed joint cements, grouts, caulks, spackling compounds, rubber compounds, latexes, adhesives for non-food contact surfaces and vinyl and plastic applications where the control of microorganisms is required. Use levels range from 0.35% to 0.75% based on the total weight of the product being treated. Typical application would require the addition of 5.6 to 12 oz. by weight of preservative per 100 lbs. of product.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

CORROSIVE. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. HARMFUL OR FATAL IF SWALLOWED. When using this product eye shields, rubber gloves, a pesticide respirator and protective clothing should be worn. Do not breath spray mist. Use with adequate ventilation. 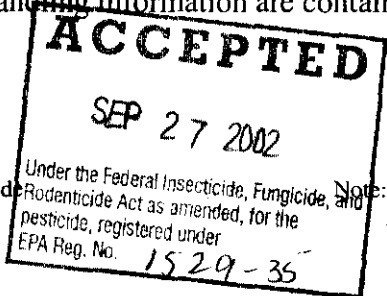
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
