DANGER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A low viscosity formulation used in the preservation of ready-mixed joint cements, grouts, caulks, spackling compounds, rubber compounds, adhesives for non-food contact surfaces and vinyl and plastic applications where the control of microorganisms is required. Use levels range from 0.35% to 0.75% based on the total weight of the product being treated. Typical application would require the addition of 5.6 to 12 oz. by weight of preservative per 100 lbs. of product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS - Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL - Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
