The EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of the subject product.

1. Make the following label changes:

a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "1529-36".

b. Per the acute toxicity review, the following revisions are needed to the first aid statements:

-Revise the heading "IF ON SKIN" to read "IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING".

-Based on toxicity ranking per the acute toxicity review, the First Aid statements should be must be placed on the label in the following order:

"IF IN EYES:
IF INHALED: ...
IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: ...
IF SWALLOWED: ..."

c. Additional text must be added to the Note to Physician that addresses eye irritation concerns.

d. Per the acute toxicity review, the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals must be revised to read:

"DANGER
Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, or on clothing. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves. Wash hands before, eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse"

e. Per the product chemistry review, revisions are needed to the storage and disposal section of the label. Please comply with PR Notice 2007-4.

2. For additional labeling clarity and consistency, please refer to the enclosed EPA reviews.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec.6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Submit two (2) copies of the revised labeling bearing the labeling revisions listed above. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
