

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

DANGER

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A water soluble, liquid organic biocide (also called an antimicrobial or in-can preservative), recommended for use as an industrial preservative for the protection of caulks, sealants, grouts, spackling, ready-mixed wallboard compounds, water-based resin emulsions, latex paints, adhesives, inks, dispersed colors and ready-mixed joint cements against microbial deterioration. Typical use levels range from 0.05 to 0.5% by weight in the final formulation. An amount of 0.5 to a maximum of 5.0 gallons of Nuosept® 166 Preservative per 100 gallons of product can be added for treatment against microbial deterioration.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS - Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
