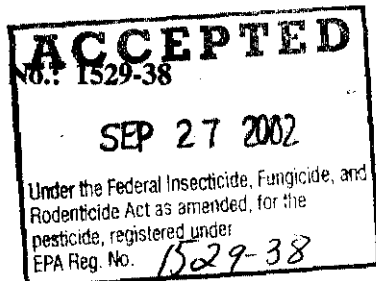

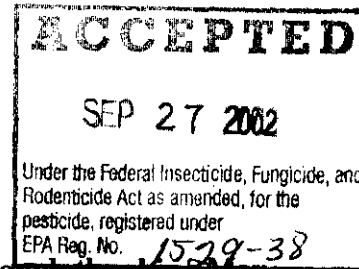
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
