On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration Number 1529-41."
- b. The Company Name on the label must be changed to "International Specialty Products along with the correct address.
- c. The correct EPA establishment number must also be provided on the label.

d. The draft label incorrectly identifies the product as a manufacturing-use product by stating "For Manufacturing Use Only". **Fungitrol 420 Fungicide is an end-use product.** Therefore you must delete the statement "For Manufacturing Use Only" from the label.

e. The Storage and Disposal text must be revised as follows:

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not store with strong oxidizing agents or strong (concentrated) acids. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not reuse container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance".

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer...If burned, stay out of smoke.

f. Add the following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) language.

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- Coveralls worn over long sleeved shirt and long pants,
- Chemical-resistant footwear plus socks
- Goggles or face shield
- Chemical-resistant gloves (such as: barrier laminate, butyl rubber, neoprene rubber, nitrile rubber, polyvinyl chloride (PVC) and viton).

g. The following User Safety Requirements must be added to the label:

Follow manufacturers' instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

h. The following User Safety Recommendations text must be added to the label:

User Safety Recommendations

"Users must wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users must remove PPE clothing immediately after handling this product. Wash gloves outside before removing. As soon as possible, wash. Thoroughly and change into clean clothing".

i. **For Cleaning Equipment:**

-Chemical-resistant apron

j. Delete the second word "Caution" in the Precautionary Statement section. In addition the precautionary statement must be revised to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapors. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse".

k. Since there no specific instructions on the label as to how this product is to be processed, I assume there is a technical manual associated with the product. If so, submit a copy of the technical manual for the file.


3. The requirements of PR Notice 91-2 were not satisfied. The nominal concentration of the active ingredient given in the proposed Basic CSF does not agree with the percentage on the label. The correct label declaration for the active ingredient (A.I.) must be 20% and not 20.00% as shown on the draft label. The true nominal concentration (N) for the A.I. is 19.9% (20% (wt)X99.5% (N) of Fungitrol 400)=19.9% which can be rounded to 20%. Rounding the percent concentration of the A.I. to 20.00%, as was done on the label, is not permitted.

4. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label bearing the revisions prior to releasing this product for sale.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
