Dear Mr. Heyward:

On behalf of International Specialty Products ("ISP"), I am submitting an application for pesticide notification to add the following indoor, non-food use sites to the labels of the above-referenced products: pigment dispersions, slurries, gypsum slurries for wallboard (drywall and gypsum board), and HI&I applications.

Per our telephone communication of earlier this week, I understand that you agreed with the definitions that ISP presented for pigment dispersions, slurries, and wallboard and requested that we submit the addition of these use sites via Notification. Regarding the addition of HI&I applications, I am providing you with product information for a similar IPBC product that the Agency has already approved for these uses. The name of the product is Omacide IPBC 30 DPG (EPA Reg. No. 1258-1230), registered by Arch Chemicals, Inc. Attached is a copy of the most recent EPA stamped accepted label for your review.

To support this notification, I am submitting the following documents for your review:

- 1. Application for Pesticide Notification (OPP ID No. 265394) for each product, which includes a signed statement certifying compliance with PR Notice 98-10;
- 2. One (1) copy of each proposed product label with the use sites highlighted; and,
- 3. One (1) clean copy of each proposed product label.

I would appreciate anything that can be done to expedite the review of this Notification as we need to submit to the states before they start to process end-of-year renewals.

MIXERS AND HANDLERS: Read Precautionary Statements prior to handling product.

Add Fungitrol 420S Fungicide as directed below to the coating for maximum protection against mold, mildew, and algae. Mix thoroughly, stirring Fungitrol 420S Fungicide into the coating for 2 - 3 minutes. Apply the coating to the surface as directed by the coating manufacturer. In all cases, the coating should be mixed prior to applying to the surface. To ensure best results, follow coating manufacturer's instructions for cleaning and preparing the surface. Fungitrol 420S Fungicide is for protecting the applied film and paint, not the substrate.

For 1.5 oz. pillowpack: Cut off corners as marked and squeeze entire contents into 1 gallon of paint or other coating. Shake or stir thoroughly for 2 - 3 minutes.

For 7.5 oz. plastic jar: Pour entire contents into 5 gallons of paint or other coating. Shake or stir thoroughly for 2 - 3 minutes.

For 2.48 lbs. plastic container with pump: Add 1 oz. (2 squirts) per gallon of paint or other coating. Shake or stir thoroughly.

For 2.48 lbs. and 4.95 lbs. plastic containers: Pour Fungitrol 420S Fungicide into color canister. Dispense as shown in **Table A**. Shake or stir thoroughly.

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### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**
