On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above-named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

- b. Add the new "EPA Establishment Number" on the label.
- c. Add the new "Company Name and Address" on the label.
- d. Revise the first aid statement to read as follows:

FIRST AID		
IF IN EYES:	•Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. •Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. •Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.	
IF SWALLOWED:	•Call Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. •Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. •Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the Poison Control Center or doctor.

c. Revise the precautionary statements to read as follows:

"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

- d. Add a subheading "Pesticide Storage" below the Storage and Disposal.
- e. Under the subheading "Pesticide Storage" move the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal" and place it directly under the "Storage and Disposal" subheading.

f. Add the following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) language.

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- Coveralls worn over long sleeved shirt and long pants,
- Chemical-resistant footwear plus socks
- Goggles or face shield
- Chemical-resistant gloves (such as: barrier laminate, butyl rubber, neoprene rubber, nitrile rubber, polyvinyl chloride (PVC) and viton).
- g. The following User Safety Requirements must be added to the label:

Follow manufacturers' instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

h. The following User Safety Recommendations text must be added to the label:

#### User Safety Recommendations

"Users must wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users must remove PPE clothing immediately after handling this product. Wash gloves outside before removing. As soon as possible, wash. Thoroughly and change into clean clothing".

- 3. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula dated December 10, 2001 is not acceptable for the following reasons:
  - 1. The requirements of PR Notice 91-2 were not satisfied. The nominal concentration of the active ingredient given in the proposed basic CSF did not agree with the percentage declared on the label.

- 2. The correct label declaration for the active ingredient (A.I.) must be 30%, and not 30.00% as shown on the draft label. The true nominal concentration (N) for the A.I. is 29.85% (30% (wt) X 99.5% (N) of Fungitrol 400) = 29.85%) which can be rounded to 30% as was done in the CSF. Rounding the percent concentration of the A.I. to 30.00%, as was done on the label, is not permitted.
- 3. The draft label incorrectly identifies the product as a manufacturing-use product by stating "For Manufacturing Use Only". Fungitrol 430 Fungicide is an end-use product.
- 4. Submit a revised basic CSF to this Agency for review.

Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label bearing the revisions prior to releasing this product for sale.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
