The following are suggested use levels for Fungitrol® 430S Fungicide. The suggested use levels of Fungitrol® 430S Fungicide are given in percentage by weight.

For use as a preservative in manufacturing dry film paint generally use 0.4-3.0% in wet paint, for aqueous metal working, cutting, cooling and lubricating fluids and concentrates use 0.1-1.75%, for paper coatings use 0.5-2.85%, for plastics and plastic coatings use 0.17-3.75%, for cordage use 1.0-4.0%, for inks use 0.2-3.5%, for pigment dispersions, slurries, and gypsum slurries for wallboard (drywall and gypsum board) use 0.013-3%. For household, consumer, industrial, institutional, and janitorial products (such as liquid and solid air fresheners, dish detergents, laundry products, soaps and detergents, non-food contact surface cleaners, floor care products, bathroom cleaners, window cleaners, fabric care products, automotive care products, and furniture care products), use 0.013-0.1%. For wood preservation, use only in above-ground applications at 0.1-6.0%. Fungitrol[®] 430S Fungicide can be used as a fungicide in non-medical, non food contact aqueous, solvent and non-solvent based systems such as natural and synthetic adhesives, caulks, patching compounds, sealants, grouts, latexes such as sbr/latex used in the manufacture of flooring adhesives or carpet backings and for use in cement-based products. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Shake for 10 seconds. Pour the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Dain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.

[Note to reviewer: the following language will be used for containers greater than 50 lbs]

CONTAINER HANDLING - Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into applications equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container (4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll back and forth ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment empirically or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.
