On behalf of International Specialty Products ("ISP"), I am submitting an application for pesticide notification to add the following indoor, non-food use sites to the labels of the above-referenced products: pigment dispersions, slurries, gypsum slurries for wallboard (drywall and gypsum board), and HI&I applications.

Per our telephone communication of earlier this week, I understand that you agreed with the definitions that ISP presented for pigment dispersions, slurries, and wallboard and requested that we submit the addition of these use sites via Notification. Regarding the addition of HI&I applications, I am providing you with product information for a similar IPBC product that the Agency has already approved for these uses. The name of the product is Omicide IPBC 30 DPG (EPA Reg. No. 1258-1230), registered by Arch Chemicals, Inc. Attached is a copy of the most recent EPA stamped accepted label for your review.

To support this notification, I am submitting the following documents for your review:

1. Application for Pesticide Notification (OPP ID No. 265394) for each product, which includes a signed statement certifying compliance with PR Notice 98-10;
2. One (1) copy of each proposed product label with the use sites highlighted; and,

For use as a preservative in manufacturing dry film paint generally use 0.1-2.0% in wet paint, for aqueous metal working, cutting, cooling and lubricating fluids and concentrates use 0.05-0.5%, for paper coatings use 0.05-2.0%, for plastics and plastic coatings use 0.5-2.5%, for cordage use 0.5-2.5%, for inks use 0.05-3.0%, for pigment dispersions, slurries, gypsum slurries for wallboard (drywall and gypsum board) use 0.01-2%.
