On behalf of International Specialty Products ("ISP"), I am submitting an application for pesticide notification to add the following indoor, non-food use sites to the labels of the above-referenced products: pigment dispersions, slurries, gypsum slurries for wallboard (drywall and gypsum board), and HI&I applications.

Per our telephone communication of earlier this week, I understand that you agreed with the definitions that ISP presented for pigment dispersions, slurries, and wallboard and requested that we submit the addition of these use sites via Notification. Regarding the addition of HI&I applications, I am providing you with product information for a similar IPBC product that the Agency has already approved for these uses. The name of the product is Omacide IPBC 30 DPG (EPA Reg. No. 1258-1230), registered by Arch Chemicals, Inc. Attached is a copy of the most recent EPA stamped accepted label for your review.

To support this notification, I am submitting the following documents for your review:

- Application for Pesticide Notification (OPP ID No. 265394) for each product, which includes a signed statement certifying compliance with PR Notice 98-10;
- One (1) copy of each proposed product label with the use sites highlighted; and,
- One (1) clean copy of each proposed product label.

I would appreciate anything that can be done to expedite the review of this Notification as we need to submit to the states before they start to process end-of-year renewals.

The following are suggested use levels for Fungitrol® 440S Fungicide. The suggested use levels of Fungitrol® 440S Fungicide are given in percentage by weight.

For use as a preservative in manufacturing dry film paint generally use 0.1-2.0% in wet paint, for aqueous metal working, cutting, cooling and lubricating fluids and concentrates use 0.05-0.5%, for paper coatings use 0.05-2.0%, for plastics and plastic coatings use 0.5-2.5%, for cordage use 0.5-2.5%, for inks use 0.05-3.0%, for pigment dispersions, slurries, gypsum slurries for wallboard (drywall and gypsum board) use 0.01-2%. For household, consumer, industrial, institutional, and janitorial products (such as liquid and solid air fresheners, dish detergents, laundry products, soaps and detergents, non-food contact surface cleaners, floor care products. bathroom cleaners, window cleaners, fabric care products, automotive care products, and furniture care products), use 0.01-0.075%.
