For use as a fungicide in non-aqueous paints, coatings and caulking compounds. Fungitrol® 11-50S should be used at twice the use level of powdered Fungitrol® 11 and it is recommended for use in all non-aqueous paint systems. It can be added at any phase of manufacture. Dosage levels will vary depending on the nature of the product formulation and specific environments involved. Generally, levels of Fungitrol® 11-50S between 1.0-3.0% by weight should be considered.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE - Store indoors in a cool, dry place. Protect from heat and flame. Wear organic vapor respirator, face shield and rubber gloves when opening container and transferring contents. Reseal open container. If pesticide is spilled, extinguish sources of ignition, ventilate area and cover spill with inert absorbent material. Sweep up and dispose of as below.
