



DANGER

- Paper coatings, plastics and plastic coatings, cordage, inks, and wood preservatives.
- Non-medical, non-food contact aqueous, solvent and non-solvent based systems such as natural and synthetic adhesives, caulks, patching compounds, sealants, grouts, latexes such as sbr/latex used in the manufacture of flooring adhesives or carpet backings.
- Cement based products.
- Pigment dispersions and slurries.
- Gypsum slurries for wallboard (drywall and gypsum board).
- Household, consumer, industrial, institutional, and janitorial products such as liquid and solid air fresheners, dish detergents, laundry products, soaps and detergents, non-food contact surface cleaners, floor care products, bathroom cleaners, window cleaners, fabric care products, automotive care products, and furniture care products.

Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.

[Note to reviewer: the following language will be used for containers greater than 50 lbs]

CONTAINER HANDLING - Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll back and forth ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.
