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- **b.** Under the *Storage and Disposal* section, insert the following language: "Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container".
- c. You list the use rates at "ppm" levels. While this is acceptable, the label must also reflect rates that will aid the user in measuring without any ambiguity or additional calculation on his/her part (i.e., x ounces per y gallons).
- d. On page 2, delete statement at the bottom of the page that begins "Levels of Nuosept W Concentrate can be increased..." You list typical use rates in the earlier portion of the labeling and then you suggest that the user could increase the rate under certain circumstances under this section. Label rates should reflect the maximum use rate allowed under all conditions. Therefore, this statement needs to be omitted.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### DANGER

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Do not breathe spray mist. Mixers, applicants and all other users should wash hands with soap and water before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If pesticide gets inside clothing remove clothing immediately, wash thoroughly, and put on clean clothing. This product may cause skin sensitization reactions in some people.

Mixers, loaders and other handlers must wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants; shoes plus socks; chemical resistant gloves such as barrier laminate, butyl rubber, nitrile rubber, neoprene rubber, or polyvinyl chloride; protective eyewear such as goggles or face shield; and a chemical resistant apron. As soon as possible wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Discard clothing or other absorbent materials that have been drenched or heavily contaminated with this product's concentrate. Do not reuse them.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons.

Nuosept W is a liquid in-can preservative and may be added at any point in the production process. For best results add it as early as possible in the manufacturing process. Avoid high temperature/high alkaline conditions.

Typical usages rates are 0.05 – 0.2 % by wt. (35 – 140 ppm bronopol and 5 - 20 ppm isothiazolones) for adhesives and tackifiers (such as animal glues, rubber lattices, acrylic lattices), paints and coatings (such as architectural paints, water coatings such as for paper or wood, emulsions), building materials (such as caulks, joint cements, grouts, mastics, sealants, spackling, ready-to-mix cement, tape joint compounds), wallboard (drywall and gypsum board); lattices (such as synthetic and natural polymer lattices, starches and casein derived polymers, protein derived polymers), fountain solutions for lithographic printing operations, photo processing, inks/ink components, metal working and metal cleaning fluids, industrial water such as process water, wash water and waste water; industrial cooling water and air washer systems, consumer household and institutional products (such as dishwashing detergents, laundry detergents, laundry pre-spotters, fabric softeners, laundry spray starch, surface cleaners, all-purpose liquid cleaners, anti-tarnish products, furniture and floor polishes, carpet shampoos and carpet pre-spotters, automotive cleaners, waxes, and polishes) as well as for package utility products such as pre-moistened sponges and mops; and other aqueous compositions such as emulsions and dispersions, pesticide formulations; pigment dispersions and slurries.

Devels of Nuosept W can be increased, however should not exceed 40 ppm isothiazolopes and 280 ppm bronopol (0.4 % by wt.). For specific recommendations as to the amount of product to use, please contact SP.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to terrestrial and aquatic plants, fish and aquatic invertebrates. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL** - Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.
