

We recently received registration for the above referenced product and became aware of an error in the prominence or order of the First Aid Statements on the EPA stamped Master label (dated January 6, 2011). While creating the label, we inadvertently changed the order of the First Aid statements. This formatting error does not modify any label text.

The order of the First Aid Statements should be the following:

- IF IN EYES
- IF INHALED
- IF SWALLOWED
- IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING

CONTAINER DISPOSAL - Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll back and forth ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.
