DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove loose dirt prior to application. Moisten towel with Absorbine Flyshield and apply with the growth of hair. It is not desirable to wet the hide. A daily application of Absorbine Flyshield is usually sufficient but adverse weather conditions such as heavy showers or extremely high humidity may affect repellancy. Application should not exceed 1 to 2 ounces daily depending on the size of the horse.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Pyrethrine 0.20%, Piperonyl Butoxide Technical 2.00% (Equivalent to 1.60% (butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and .40% of related compounds); Butoxypolypropylene Glycol 15.00%
