We indicated in our December 16, 2003 letter that this claim would be acceptable, based on our incorrect determination that the claim had been approved on the label for Absorbine Ultra Shield® Brand Residual Insecticide & Repellent (EPA Reg. No. 1543-12). In fact, this product label never included a tick claim for horses and ponies, only dogs. If you wish to add a claim for ticks on horses/ponies, you must submit/cite efficacy data to support the claim.
- 3. Please submit two copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

HORSES AND PONIES: Kills and repels biting and nuisance flies, mosquitoes and gnats for up to 17 days. Repels and kills house flies, stable flies, horn flies, face flies, horse flies, deer flies, black flies, mosquitoes and gnats on horses. Kills and repels ticks for 3 – 5 days.

USE AS A WIPE OR A SPRAY: This product may be applied either as a wipe or as a spray. When applying as a wipe, or on the horse's face, always use a soft cloth. First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Spray or wipe horse's entire body while brushing against the lay of the coat to ensure adequate coverage. Avoid getting spray into horse's eyes, nose or mouth. Do not wet skin, or apply to the point of dripping or exceed two ounces per application. Reapply every 7 to 10 days under normal conditions for initial applications. As protection builds, reapply every 12 to 17 days as needed. Also, reapply each time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain for best results. After application, brush thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.

DOGS: Kills fleas, ticks, mosquitoes and lice on dogs. Also kills fleas, ticks, mosquitoes and lice around premise. Cover animal's eyes with hands. With a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With soft cloth, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs rub against the lay of the hair spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. During the flea season retreat every 3 - 4 weeks if necessary. Kills fleas, ticks and lice on dogs and provides up to 28 days protection from reinfestation. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product on pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water.
