DIRECTIONS:

For Moth Prevention: Remove cellophane from pad and replace in box.

Tear down front panel to ventilate the pad.

Hang or place Paradichlorobenzene Pad near top of container or closet as the fumes are heavier than air. Brush articles thoroughly before storing. Use one Zo-ex Pad to every 15 cubic feet of tightly confined storage space, such as storage chests, trunks and storage closets. Do not open for at least 7 days. If storage space is opened, replace Zorex Moth Pad and keep closet or container air-tight for at least 7 days.

Do not mix with other moth-preventive chemicals.

To retard Mildew: Place the Zorex Pad in area or container where leather and clothing are stored, particularly damp areas. Hang or place Paradichlorobenzene Pad near top of container or closet as fumes are heavier than air. Storage areas or containers should be tightly sealed after application. Use at rate of 1 Zorex Pad to 18 cu. ft. of air-tight space. If storage area or container is opened, add additional product and keep tightly closed for at least 7 days.

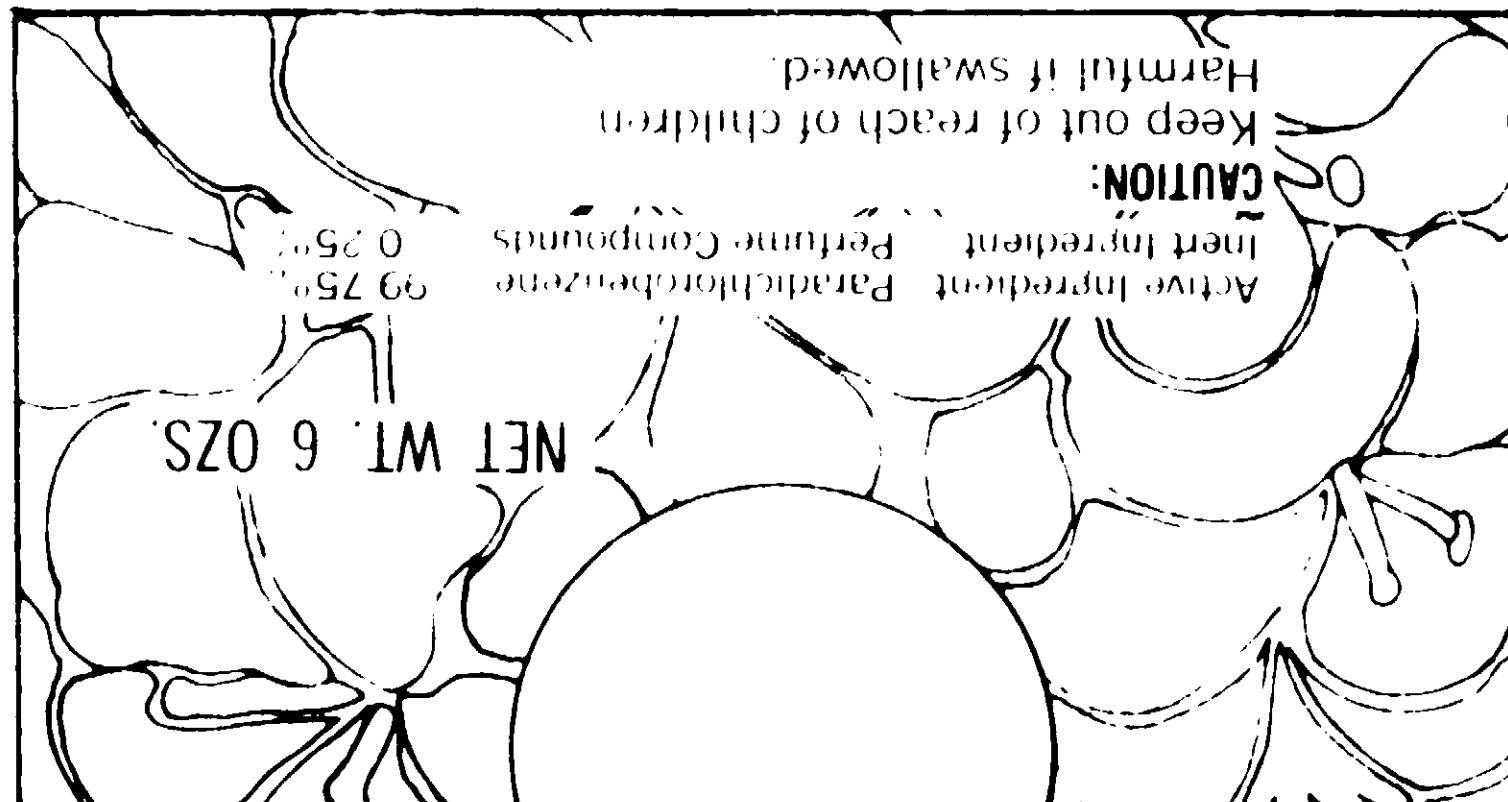

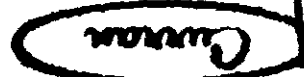
