

## CONTROLLED FOAMING

In used dilutions it has a rich amber color. Just as long as any color remains in this solution, complete and rapid germicidal action is assured. Once this color has disappeared, the solution should be reinstated.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** For general cleaning and disinfecting in a single operation, use 6 ounces of DIXIDYNE to 5 gallons of water. Use a scrub brush, rag or mop to insure thorough cleaning. For porous surfaces or those difficult to clean use 2 ounces of DIXIDYNE to 2 gallons of water.

## GENERAL PURPOSE GERMICIDE FOR POULTRY AND MEAT PACKING PLANTS

Wash utensils and equipment using 3 ounces of DIXIDYNE to 4 gallons of water, rinse thoroughly in fresh water. Dip in a solution of 1 ounce DIXIDYNE to 5 gallons of water for at least 2 minutes or for the contact time specified by the government Sanitary Code. To avoid any possible contamination of food or beverage, rinse off sanitizing solution until foaming has disappeared. Floors and walls, use a solution of 3 ounces of DIXIDYNE to 5 gallons of water for cleaning, sanitizing floors and walls.

DIXIDYNE is not adversely affected by hard water most commonly encountered. It helps prevent odors and will not stain.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Causes skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact flush skin or eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes get medical attention. Avoid contamination of foods.

If DIXIDYNE should come in contact with eyes, rinse well with water. Do not use soap or alkaline material with DIXIDYNE. If irritation persists, get medical attention.
