

HOW TO USE:

After dilution Momar Bug Out may be applied with either power operated or hand sprayers. Apply as a coarse spray to infected surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Direct spray away from people, plants and pets.

RESTRICTIONS:

Do not apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper or similar materials that may be stained. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces such as tiles and floor coverings. Do not allow small, finger-operated, plastic attachment type sprayer to remain in Momar Bug Out for extended periods as the plastic sprayer may be damaged.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**Important:**

Read these entire directions before using Momar Bug Out Residual Insecticide. Dilute 1 part Momar Bug Out with 10 parts water and use this dilution as follows:

INDOOR USE:

ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (EXPOSED STAGE), WATERBUGS. Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until surfaces are thoroughly dry.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and under door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

OUTDOOR USE:

ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, FLIES, MILLIPEDES, MOSQUITOES, SOWBUGS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

FOR USE IN FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS:

Use only in inedible product area. Spray when not in operation. Do not apply in the edible products areas of food processing plants. Follow directions on label for indoor use.

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Contact with skin, eyes or clothing should also be avoided. Wash thoroughly after using. Do not apply in the edible products areas of food processing plants. Should illness occur, get prompt medical aid. To Physician — Atropine sulfate is antidotal. Destroy empty container — Do not reuse.
