### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### IMPORTANT:

Read these entire directions before using BUG OUT. Dilute 1 part BUG OUT with 10 parts water and use this dilution as follows:

#### INDOOR USE:

ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (EXPOSED STAGE), WATERBUGS. Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until surfaces are thoroughly dry.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, and under door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

#### OUTDOOR USE:

ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, FLIES, MILLIPEDES, MOSQUITOES, SOWBUGS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

#### FOR USE IN FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS:

Use only in inedible product area. Spray when not in operation. Do not apply in the edible products areas of food processing plants. Follow directions on label for indoor use.

#### HOW TO USE:

After dilution BUG OUT must be applied using a compressed air sprayer. DO NOT apply this product using a trigger pump sprayer. Apply as a coarse spray to infested surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Direct spray away from people, plants, and pets.

#### RESTRICTIONS:

Do not apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper or similar materials that may be stained. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces such as tiles and floor coverings.
