N-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide675%

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General: Select a hand or electric sprayer that gives fine particles when using this spray against listed flying insects (such as Momar X-15 or Green Hornet). Select a sprayer that gives large, wetting spray particles when using this spray as a contact spray against listed crawling insects (Such as Momar Atomaster Sprayer). Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths: Close doors and windows. Fog or spray enclosed space at the rate of 1-2 fl. oz. per 1000 cu. ft. Leave room closed 10 to 15 minutes. Open doors and windows and ventilate room before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat applications as necessary.

To Kill German Cockroaches: Apply as a wet spray thoroughly to infested surfaces and harborages. Force spray into all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, contacting as many insects as possible with the spray. Repeat applications as necessary.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Harmful if swallowed. Do not apply directly to food. See instructions in general directions when using this product around food or food processing areas. Do not store, pour or spill near fire or open flame.

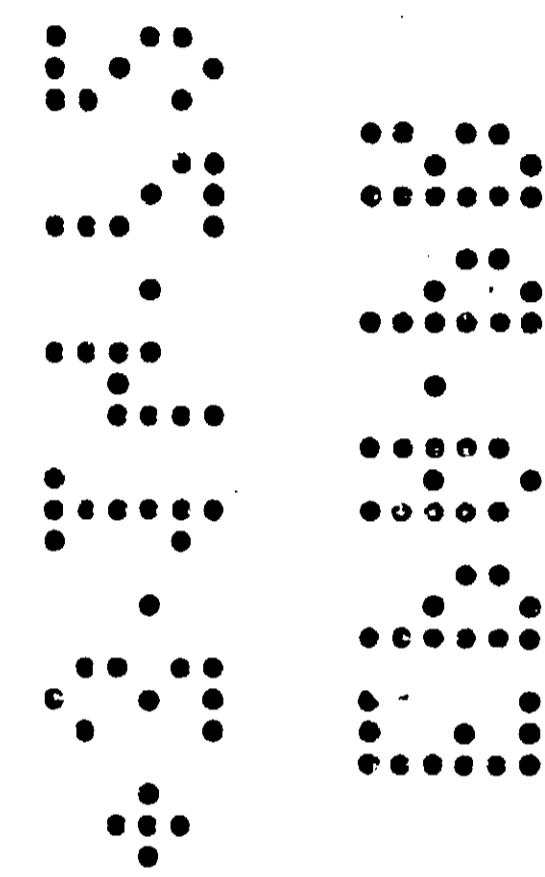
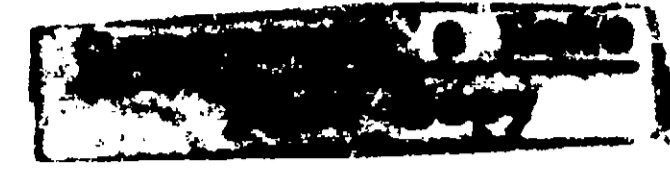
