

1. Change contact time from "60 seconds" to "at least 2 minutes."
2. Add the statement "Let Air Dry" after use directions (see enclosed label).
3. Under First Aid: If Swallowed, delete "drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available. . . ."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID): In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least fifteen minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, ~~drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available,~~ drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL

STORAGE: If contents are spilled or leaked due to container damage, collect liquid with absorbent material and dispose of in accordance with Local, State, and Federal pesticide disposal regulations.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL. Metal Containers — Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and Local authorities. Plastic Containers — Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by State and Local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
