MOMAR SPRAY DIS Detergent Disinfectant has been designed specifically for Institutional cleaning and disinfecting in Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels.

DISINFECTION, CLEANING, AND DEODORIZING: To disinfect, clean, and deodorize hard non porous surfaces such as bathroom tiles, fixtures, shower stalls, walls, sinks and bathtubs, proceed as indicated below:

1 Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated 2 Spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow the product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing necessary 3 Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop, or sponge. The product will not leave grit or soap scum.

For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

MILDEWSTAT — To control mold and mildew on hard non porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), spray the surfaces to be treated, making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

 PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

NET CONTENTS:

MOMAR SPRAY DIS Detergent Disinfectant is designed for general cleaning and disinfecting in Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Institutions, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels. When used as directed, MOMAR SPRAY DIS Detergent/Disinfectant is formulated to disinfect inanimate hard surfaces (such as walls, sink tops, tables, chairs, telephones, door knobs, light switches, shower stalls, hampers, cabinets, and bed springs).

In addition, MOMAR SPRAY DIS Detergent/Disinfectant deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, basements, restrooms, and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

When used as directed, MOMAR SPRAY DIS Detergent/Disinfectant demonstrates effective disinfection against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa (thus meeting requirements for hospital use). Efficacy tests have demonstrated that MOMAR SPRAY DIS Detergent/Disinfectant is an effective one-step cleaner/disinfectant in the presence of organic soil (5% blood serum).

The product is fungicidal against Pathogenic fungi (Trichoglyphes), when used as directed on hard surfaces found in the bathroom, shower stall, and locker room, or other clean hard non porous surfaces commonly contacted by the bare feet.

MOLD AND MILDEWSTAT — MOMAR SPRAY DIS Detergent/Disinfectant prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non porous inanimate surfaces.
