The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Move the Storage and Disposal Section to the end of the label. It is not necessary to put the introductory sentence in a larger font if you have space constraints.
- 2) Remove all places on the label where you indicate "apply liberally".

Although we still encourage inclusion, we have determined that it is acceptable to exclude the phrase from your label, "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you". You do not need to submit an amendment to remove this from your label.
