

- 1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. On the left panel, revise the precautionary statements to read:

Precautionary Statements

Danger. Corrosive. Keep Out of Reach Children. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggle or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. b. Change the heading "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment" and revise the instructions to read: If tablets are swallowed, drink promptly large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention immediately.



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- c. In the "Note to Physician" section, delete the last sentence beginning with "measures against may be needed.
- d. Delete the following misleading statements:

- 2. Submit an updated Confidential Statement of Formula, EPA Form 8570-4 for our review. A copy of the form is enclosed.
- 3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellatin in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling contstitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
