Developers for use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use instructions. Use clothes moths larvae and adults and carpet beetles in clean, air-tight containers (e.g., dress and trunk, garment bags and storage chests). Do not use in containers, dry cleaning and garage bags, or chests that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. Do not use the product with any other moth control chemical. As paradichlorobenzene damages some plastics, do not use in plastic garment bags. For use only on cloth containing wool or wool blends. Pre-application: Dry clean, air-tight containers, bags and chests first above. Use one inch for every 10 cubic feet for larger chests, multiply the height, width and depth of the space and divide by 10 to determine the number of chests needed. For example: a chest 3 feet high, 4 feet wide, and 3 feet deep is 36 cubic feet would need about 10 chests (36/3.6=10). Post-application: Dry clean, air-tight containers, bags and chests for a minimum of seven (7) days. Other dangers: When treated articles are dried, re-treatment seven months after use. Active all year. Repairs in airtight containers, bags and chests 2 times a year.
